#### It goes the other way too...


In 1950, Detroit was the wealthiest city in America on a per capita income basis.



Today, the Census Bureau reports that it is the nation's 2nd poorest major city, just "edging out" Cleveland.





#### Could the fear be an excuse?







  - Hobby or interest




## Finding Ideas
